District

Olentangy Local School District, located in southern Delaware County, covers 95 square miles and remains one of the fastest growing districts in Ohio and in the nation. Olentangy Local Schools is ranked in the top 4% of all school districts in the state of Ohio.

School

Olentangy Berlin High School opened in August of 2018 as a four year public high school (grades 9-11 for the inaugural year only) with a present enrollment of 1475 students. There will be 330 students in the 2021 graduating class. Olentangy High School, where the majority of our students moved from, is ranked in the top 3.9% of all schools in the state of Ohio.

Faculty Graduation Requirements Olentangy Berlin High School has 95 certified staff members, many of whom have earned a Master's Degree or beyond. The curriculum at Olentangy Berlin High school is comprehensive including advanced placement, honors, occupational, and vocational programs. For the graduating class of 2021, twenty-two credits will be required. Specific requirements include elective courses and the required course of study:

3 units Science 4 units English 4 units Math 1 unit Fine/Performing Art 1/2 unit Health

3 units Social Studies 1/2 unit Physical Education

Honors & Advanced **Placement** Honors courses are unweighted and are available in 9th grade English, 10th grade English, World History, U.S. History, Geometry, Algebra II, Pre-Calculus, Physical Science, Biology, and Chemistry.

AP courses are weighted and are offered in World History, American Government/Politics, American History, English Language and Composition, English Literature and Composition, Seminar, Research, Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Physics I, Physics/Mechanics, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Statistics, Computer Science A, Computer Science Principles, Psychology, Art History, Music Theory, Micro Economics, Macro Economics, Spanish, German and French.

CCP courses are weighted and are specified with the college/university abbreviation, department abbreviation and course code. College/University abbreviations are: CS - Columbus State Community College, CU - Cedarville University, MT - Marion Technical College, ODU - Ohio Dominican University, OSU - Ohio State University, OTT - Otterbein University, OU - Ohio University, OWU - Ohio Wesleyan University.
